Famous Trials - 1954

True stories of crime and judgement gathered from police files, secret service dossiers and the archives of courtrooms from all over the world. Our featured episode is: *The Trial of Ned Kelly* and stars Frank Waters as Ned Kelly and Ric Hutton is the narrator.
